

# Make A Snow Globe

Here are some tips. If you look online you can see detailed directions and tips.

1. Choose your container. It can be glass or plastic as long as it's see-through. It doesn't have to be any specific shape. You can recycle bottles and jars you already have.
2. You can glue items to the lid to make a scene (use waterproof glue) or just use glitter or other items to float in the water.
3. Fill your container with water. Some suggest using distilled water but I think tap water is fine.
4. Some recommend adding glycerin (the amount depends on the size of your container but about 2 tbsp) to keep the glitter and other materials from sticking together.
5. You may want to glue the lid on, especially if you have little ones.
